### **PASTORS CORNER**

Hello First UMC Family,

It's that time of year again when we're all looking forward to another Easter celebration. Some will gather to share an Easter meal together. We might indulge in Easter candy from our Easter baskets. Some even celebrate Easter as a sign that the new season is coming. With warm weather abound, flowers will be rising up to life. ## READ AND REFLECT

#### Romans 8:9-11

You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ. <sup>10</sup> But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of righteousness. <sup>11</sup> And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.

## TRUSTEES REPORT

Just a few updates on what has been happening around the church.

1. Please take a walk down the hall upstairs to the lounge. Thanks to a church member, a new floor was installed along with 2 new tables and chairs. Another member donated the end tables and the long side storage unit. The coffee table and lamps were another church members donation. The new couch and love seat were purchased by the church. It was a great find at Ashley Furniture for under a thousand with free delivery. Within the next several months we hope to be able to add an area rug.

This room is used by Ernie Kelly's men's Bible study and Sunday school on Sunday mornings.

- 2. We are currently working on cleaning out the next room so our Sunday School can utilize that room as well.
- 3. We have been very fortunate that our furnace has remained running. We are quite certain that luck and lots of prayers have certainly helped our situation. All monies donated are in a special account and have not been used for any repairs or purchases.

We will be contacting Goods Heating and Air Conditioning to secure a review of their previous bid. We will also be contacting several other companies for a new look at our situation. We are going to start our furnace campaign, again. Posting updates will be in the Narthex to keep everyone informed on our progress.

4. The main church roof had 17 slates that were broken or missing, the copper rain gutters had holes, allowing water to run down the side of the stone and causing damage to the inside sanctuary walls. As well, the roof over the handicapped door had shingles missing and the flashing against the church wall was loose and coming off. The inside ceiling has been damaged some and will be repaired at a later date. This repair was approximately \$7,500. The shingle roof has not been replaced in approximately 25 year. All of this work has been paid for.

Maybe you ask, why make such expensive repairs? Well, to maintain the beautiful building we have, it takes care, love of God, and compassion. Please always keep our beautiful building in your prayers.

5. New lights have been installed in the two offices upstairs, the hallway, the 4 classrooms downstairs, the kitchen, and we are in the process of replacing the ones in fellowship hall and the stage. This was made possible as PECO allows us to purchase \$140 light fixtures for \$40 dollars each. They are LED and use very little electricity. The light which is produced is amazing. Thanks to Dale and Elsie Allen, the lift that is being used in Fellowship Hall belongs to their company. Dale purchased special tires and boots so the lift will not damage the tile floors. Ceiling tile was purchased and as the lights are installed, the old tile will be replaced. We will also service the air conditioners since we have the use of the lift.

Many people work behind the scenes and are not acknowledged but their Faith and Love of our Church fills their hearts every day.

6. Now here is the most important part. We are looking for ideas on how to raise money. Unfortunately, we have made good money on our Chicken Dinners, but we do not have the manpower to do any dinners. Our Bazaar was a lot of work and only a few hands made it happen. What ideas DO YOU HAVE, on fundraisers. Do you know of something great to sell? Do you know of an event we can participate in that will give us a profit? Are you willing to take CHARGE and share your expertise. I know the trustees are here to help you.

Please give good thought to all the above and keep all these projects in your Prayers.
